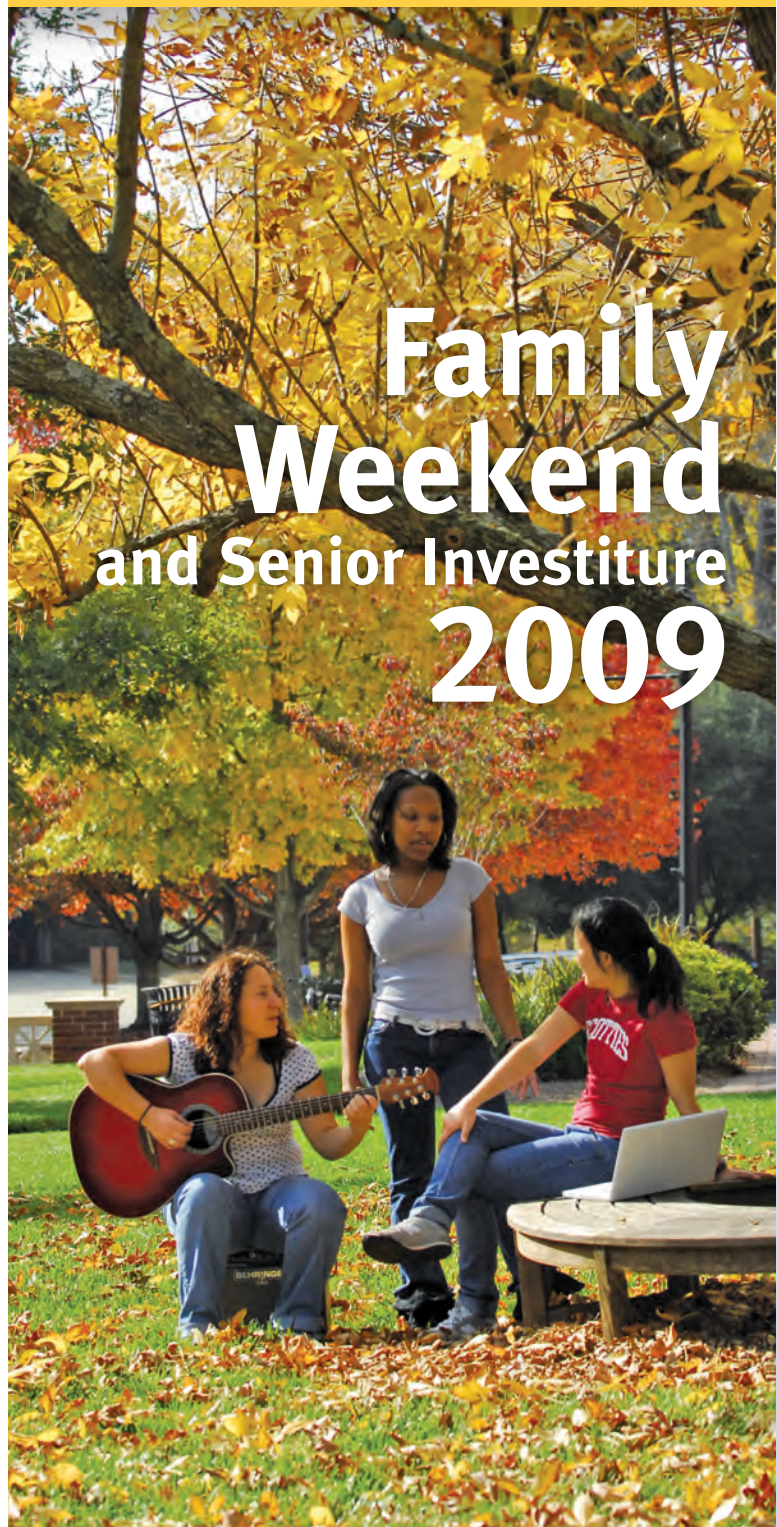

Stars align and worlds collide in this masterpiece of modern drama. History's most famous physicist and astronomer is rendered by the 20th century's most influential playwright in an adaptation by an Oscar-winning star of theatre, film and television. As Galileo presents surprising new discoveries about the heavens, his discoveries both spur the imagination and subject him to charges of heresy. Branded as an enemy of the church he finds himself caught between truth and authority. He must choose between his life and his life's work, between conscience and convenience. Blackfriars, Atlanta's oldest continuously performing theatre troupe, performs this exciting work in a bold new production. You may order tickets on the attached registration form or, when on campus, you may reserve tickets by calling extension 6248 from any campus phone or stopping by the box office in Dana Fine Arts Building. This production is part of the college's celebration of the 400th anniversary of Galileo's first astronomical use of his telescope.

The Dalton Gallery presents "Still Water," an exhibition that focuses on the complexities between humans and water in the environment, from the breakdown of manmade systems by drought or flood to the abuse of water rights. Artworks, located in the gallery and on the campus grounds, include a range of media from furniture and quilts to cut paper three-dimensional maps. The exhibit promotes the formation of a realistic future vision for sustainable growth. Exhibited artists include Steve Jarvis (Ga.), Lauren Rosenthal (N.J.), Linda Gass (Calif.) and Georgia artist William J. Nixon, who is building a larger than life salmon run where ceramic fish will jump, shimmy and swim upward alongside a 40-yard pathway on the campus.
