You and at least one parent (if dependent student) must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents and submit the form and other required documents to the financial aid office at Agnes Scott. We may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact our office as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.
